Survey Findings

A review of the agency's documentation, and an interview with staff revealed the agency's program description did not include a description of whether the agency uses emergency safety response.

Findings include:

A review of the agency's program description did not include a description of whether the agency uses emergency safety response as described in R9-20-216.

A review of the agency's policy and procedure manual revealed a policy titled "Emergency Safety Response" that gave instruction on how this should be used.

In an interview, the Executive Director acknowledged the program description did not contain the aforementioned requirement and reported the agency uses verbal de-escalation before an emergency safety response as described in R9-20-216.

The requirement for an agency to ensure each subclass for which the applicant is licensed, adopt, maintain, and have available at the agency for public review, a current written program description that includes whether the agency may use an emergency safety response was discussed with the Executive Director during the exit conference.

This citation is unrelated to the allegations.

Rule/Statute

R9-20-201. Administration

A. A licensee is responsible for the organization and management of an agency. A licensee shall:

2. For each subclass for which the licensee is licensed, adopt, maintain, and have available at the agency for public review, a current written program description that includes:

o. Whether the agency may use an emergency safety response;

Facility Response

The date (02/28/2011) represents when the facility corrected the citation and was confirmed by the Department to be back in compliance. A facility is required to submit a Plan of Correction (POC) for each citation identified during a survey. This Plan of Correction describes how the facility is going to make corrections, the facility representative responsible for making the corrections, and what systems are in place to prevent recurrence. Once the facility has submitted an acceptable Plan of Correction, the Department confirms that the citation is corrected.
