THE THREE JUVENILES, AND , WERE RETURNED TO THE FACILITY AND HAD CREATED A DISTURBANCE, TRYING TO START A RIOT AND HAD ASSAULTED STAFF MEMBERS AND OTHER CADETS.

DUE TO INJURIES ON THE HANDS OF THE STAFF MEMBERS, THE SEVERITY OF THE INJURIES TO THE THREE JUVENILES AND THE STATEMENTS OF ALL PARTIES IT APPEARED THE STAFF MEMBERS USED MORE FORCE THAN NECESSARY TO CONTROL THE JUVENILES.

ON 5/28/05 TEEN CHALLENGE MAJOR BOB MORRISON STATED THAT [REDACTED] HAD BEEN OUT BACK DOING PHYSICAL TRAINING WHEN [REDACTED] RAN INTO THE CAFETERIA, GRABBED A KITCHEN KNIFE AND ATTEMPTED TO CUT HIS WRIST. SEVERAL CUTS WERE OBSERVED ON HIS RIGHT FOREARM. THE CUTS DID NOT APPEAR TO BE SUPERFICIAL AND THE STAFF HAD TREATED THE WOUNDS. OFFICER RALEY ASKED [REDACTED] IF HE HAD INTENDED TO HARM HIMSELF AND HE STATED HE HAD. [REDACTED] SAID HE HAD ATTEMPTED SUICIDE BEFORE AND WOULD ATTEMPT IT AGAIN. HE SEEMED WITHDRAWN AND WOULD ONLY GIVE SHORT ANSWERS WHILE AVOIDING EYE CONTACT. MORRISON SAID [REDACTED] HAD NOT BEEN A DISCIPLINE PROBLEM BUT HE DID NOT WANT HIM TO RETURN TO THE INSTITUTE. MORRISON SAID A FEW WEEKS AGO [REDACTED] HAD BEEN TAKEN INTO CUSTODY UNDER A BAKER ACT. DUE TO THE INJURIES AND [REDACTED] STATEMENT HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO BAY BEHAVIORAL.

OFFICER RALEY SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] MOTHER BY PHONE. SHE STATED SHE BELIEVED THE REASON FOR ACTIONS WAS HARASSMENT BY THE TEEN CHALLENGE STAFF.
